imprecision and provides evidence that people of that era sought not to reconcile opposing categories but rather to maintain them bouchard scrutinizes the medieval use of opposites in five broad areas scholasticism romance legal disputes conversion and the construction of gender drawing on research in a series of previously unedited charters and the earliest glossa manuscripts she demonstrates that this method of constructing reality was a constitutive element of the thought of the period
